

## **NOTICE AND EXPLANATION OF PROPOSED TARIFF FILING**

**March 30, 2010**

DeltaCom, Inc. herewith gives notice of proposed revisions to its interexchange tariff as described below.

### **TX9-3013:**

The purpose of this filing to the Alaska interexchange tariff, is to introduce a minimum monthly usage charge of \$4.99 per month for customers who only subscribe to DeltaCom's long distance service and whose long distance usage falls below 400 minutes per month. The minimum monthly usage charge will be applied in addition to the per minute charge billed for any minutes used below the minimum. For example if a customer bills 200 minutes and his per minute rate is \$0.10, he will be billed \$24.99 for his long distance usage (e.g., \$20.00 for the 200 minutes he used and \$4.99 for the minimum monthly usage charge).

This tariff will be filed on April 1, 2010 with a requested effective date of April 30, 2010.
